Environmental Conservation Technology Case Study Practicals were held for exchange students on the Marine Environment and Energy Professional Training International Courses. The purpose of this class was to study expertise relating to environmental conservation and to generate opinions through group discussion and acquire techniques to review the results of these discussions in case studies using actual issues in the marine environment field.

These classes were held as an intensive course every Wednesday afternoon from 21st November to 19th December, 2012 and 13 Japan-China-Korea Program exchange students took part.

In the first sessions, there were lectures on environmental issues by the faculty member in charge of the session and the second sessions were group discussions on methods to resolve the issues alluded to in the lecture, followed by a presentation of discussion results from each group in conclusion.

Each week each group participated enthusiastically giving their opinions and some groups did not have enough time to complete their discussions. One of the exchange students remarked, 'I am glad I took the class as it was a good opportunity to hear the opinions and ideas of other exchange students of different nationalities and expertise.'
