

Japan-China-Korea International Symposium on Marine Environment and Energy

The Japan-China-Korea International Symposium on Marine Environment and Energy (hereafter referred to as the ‘Symposium’) was held on 19th January, 2013. At it is now 2 years since the university’s program (hereafter referred to as the Japan-China-Korea Program) adopted in FY2010 by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology as part of its Program for Advanced Professional Training through Japan-China-Korea Interuniversity Exchanges began, this Symposium was held with the aim of presenting the results of the studies of exchange students to and cultivating the exchange of opinions on a practical level concerning the Japan-China-Korea Program with the universities in the consortium.
