

Short-term overseas training

Short-term overseas training was held for graduate students enrolled in the Marine Environment and Energy Professional Training International Course. During this training, students stayed at a consortium university and lived together with local students, including studies, recreation, etc. The goal was for students to learn about the consortium school and circumstances in China, and to cultivate international sensibilities that are appropriate for global human resources from Asia.

This training took place over a two-week period in November 2013 at Zhejiang Ocean University (Zhoushan, Zhejiang Province, China), a consortium university, and was attended by 13 graduate students from TUMSAT.

Various types of exchange took place during the training, including lectures by Zhejiang Ocean University, research with local students, discussions related to society as a whole, research laboratory tours, and participation in sports events. The students also visited aquaculture, marine processing, and shipbuilding corporations in Zhoushan, and observed the current state of the Chinese marine product and marine industries. This was a very valuable experience for the participating graduate students, and their communication with Zhejiang Ocean University students was particularly lively.
