[From me to you]

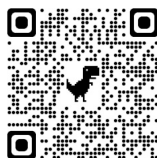

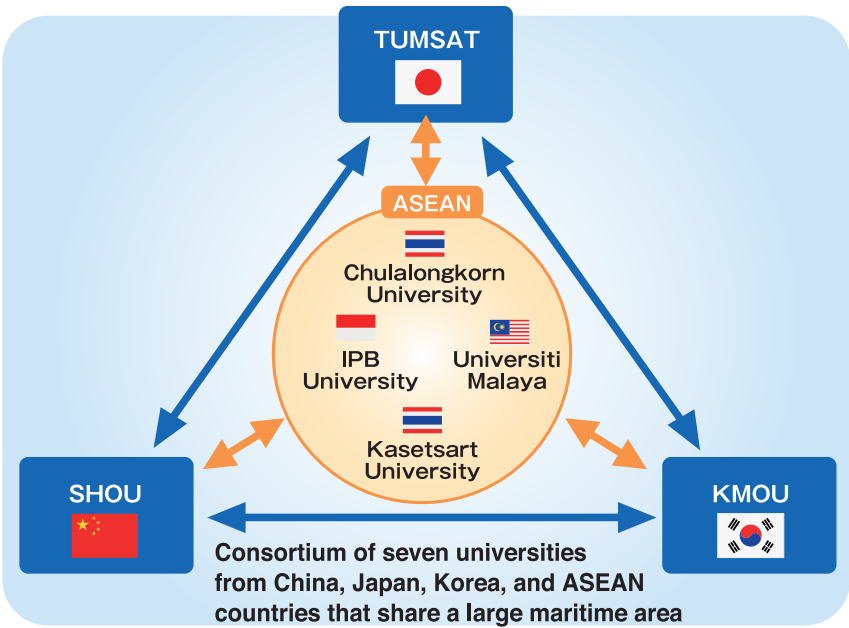

- Credits earned: Transferable to the home university under the “CTSEAA” credit transfer system

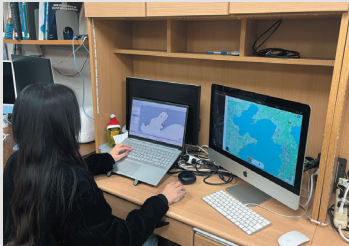
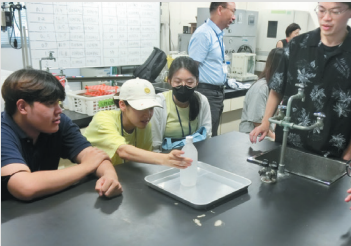
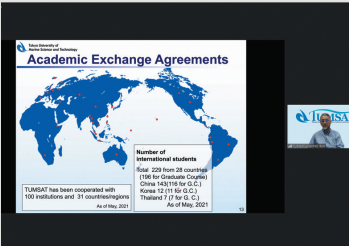


DDP Double Degree Program

For Master’s and Doctoral course students: Stay for 2 semesters (Master’s), or 3 semesters (Doctoral) at the host university:

- Research at the home and host universities for academic dissertations
- Degrees available from both universities (double degree)

Only between universities that have signed a DDP agreement. ASEAN students should check for the existence of such an agreement with their own university office.
